with the half of My stock of Cattle I do also ap-
-point Joseph C. Post & Hugh B. Stewart the sole
Executors of this My last will & Testament and do
hereby revoke all other wills made by Me herebefore
in witness whereof I haveunto set My hand & seal
this Eighth day of September & the year one thousand
eight hundred and twenty Nine as signed & sealed in pres-
ence of us -
