being in perfect health and of sound mind and memory
do make and ordain this my last will and testament
first I direct my body to be buried in decent manner
and all my just debts to be paid out of my estate
and as to my worldly goods I give and bequeath
as follows first I give to my son Isaac
Morgan one dollar to be paid out of my estate
Also I give to my son John Morgan one dollar
Also I give to my daughter Betsey Montgome
one dollar to my daughter Hannah Pennell one
dollar. Also to my daughter Polly Lewis
one dollar and the rest of my estate to be
left together during the life and widowhood
of my beloved wife Betsey Morgan but if
she marry them to be equally divided between
my seven last children that come her sons
William Charles Milton Paul and John
and Nancy Morgans. I also constitute and
appoint James Morgan Charles Morgan
and Betsey Morgan my wife my lawful
Executors and Executrix from under my
hand this 10th day of Nov 1816 in presence of
