Item I Recommend my soul to heavenly god who gave it me and my body to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors

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As touching the worldly concerns which I have possessed god be blessed with I will and dispose of in the manner following
Item and it is my will and desire that all my property both real and personal should be kept together for the use of my beloved wife Rebecca and for the raising and educating of my two children Mary Elizabeth Morris and John Gregory Morris neither either of the children should become of age or on the marriage of either of wife or children then my property both real and personal to be equally divided amongst the three. Girl named Fanny for the aforesaid men-
