will & Testament by them them freely to be possessed
and Enjoyed & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and
annul all other former testaments will Legacies
Bequests and Executors by me in any ways before named
willed & bequeathed touching & Confirming this & now other
to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof

of October in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hun-
