 In the name of god amen
 I Nathaniel Smith being
 being of sound mind and
 memory and calling to mind
 the mortality of the body do make and ordain this my
 last will and testament in manner and form
 following. I give my body to the earth to be
 entred in a decent Christian like manner and
 assign my soul to god who gave it me, and all
 my worldly goods I dispose of as follows after
 my just debts are discharged.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Nancy Smith
 all that I am now possessed of and all that I shall acquire
 during my life. I give and bequeath unto my said wife
 her dower and all her rights and interests in her
 marriage to be equally divided amongst all
 my children then living. I constitute and appoint
 my loving wife Nancy Smith and James Baggett
 my executors to this my last will
