Georgia } Being in a low State of health but sound
Baldwin County } mind I have thought proper to make this
my last will and Testament.

1st I wish all my just debts paid out of my present crop,
and out of the proceeds of such property as my executors may
seem most proper to sell the balance of my property I wish to
be held together on the plantation where I now live for
the purpose of maintaining of my wife Dicey Haws and
maintaining and educating of my children.

2nd When any of my ^{children} arrive at the age of twenty one year
old I then wish for one equal division of all my property
both real + personal to be made between my wife Dicey
Haws and all my children then living. But should my wife
Dicey Haws marry before that time I wish for the aforesaid
divisions to be then made and the childrens portions to be
put out at the best interest for the purpose of maintaining
and educating of them, and to be paid over to them such

individually arrive at the age of twenty one year old, but should my daughter Sarah marry before she arrives at that age, I wish her portion to be paid over to her at her marriage.

3^d I nominate and appoint Richard Hays and Benjamin Reynolds my executors and my wife Nancy Hays my executrix to carry into effect this my last will and testament.
