This Indenture

made the Twentieth day of September in the Year
 Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith
 the Provinces of Georgia, of the one Part, and Johoachim Noel Taming of the same Province Gentleman of the other Part did
 obtain a Judgment in the General Court of the Province aforesaid before the Kings Justice, against Robert Maillie Esquire
 Planter Decour'd for the sum of one Hundred and fourteen pounds one Shilling and five pence lawful Money of the said Province; and
whereupon a writ of fieri facias was issued out and Directed to the Sheriff Marshal of the Province of Georgia and
 one thousand seven hundred and seventy two the said writ was Delivered unto the said John Simpson then and now acting Sheriff Marshal
 that of the Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements which were of the said Robert Donaldson decour'd at the time of his death in the
 the said sum of Money mentioned and contained in the said Execution or writ of fieri facias, issued and delivered as aforesaid and
 Decour'd seized in possession and possession of the said Plantations or several Tracts of Land herein after mentioned, and particularly
 of fieri facias and of the Act of Parliament of Great Britain made in the fifth Year of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the
 and seized into his hands the aforesaid different Plantations or several Tracts of Land with the Promises and Appurtenances therunto belongyng
and whereas the said Johoachim Noel Taming was upon the said Land and Premises being so Exposed the highest
Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said John Simpson acting Sheriff
 aforesaid (being the Consideration or purchased Money for the said Plantations or Tracts of Land) to him in hand well and truly paid
 the Receipt whereof the said Sheriff Marshal doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof and of and from every part and parcel thereof doth
 and every of them for ever by these Presents hath granted bargained and sold and by these Presents under and by Virtue of the
doth Grant bargain and sell unto the Johoachim Noel Taming to his Heirs and assigns for ever all that the
 and being, in the Parish of Saint Andrew, in the Province aforesaid bounded Northwaly by Land of William Clark, Easterly by
 by Land vacant and also all the other Plantation or Tract of Land containing one hundred Acres
 aforesaid bounded on all sides by Land vacant at the time of the survey thereof, Together with all and singular the Hou
 Foodings, Commons, Woods, Coppices, Ways, Watercourses, Courses, Liberties, Priviledges, Pastures, Duties, Profits, Commodities
 any wise appertaining or Accented, Reputed, taken or known, used, enjoyed, hold Occupied, Leased or Demised in part, parcel
 Issues and Profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof with also all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Part
 Robert Donaldson decour'd in his life time had or which he the said Robert Maillie as Executor aforesaid or any other
 of or to the said Plantations or Tracts of Land and Premises above mentioned in any part or parcel thereof with
 Facias and Act of Parliament above mentioned hath a right to dispose of the same To have and to hold
 Hundred Acres (or the same more or less) with all and singular the Premises herein before mentioned or meant or Intended to
 and appurtenances unto the said Johoachim Noel Taming his Heirs and assigns to the only Use and Benefit
 and for ever In witness whereof the said Sheriff Marshal of the Province of Georgia hath hereunto set his
