ITEM IV I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved daughter, Essie E. Green sole executrix of this my last Will and Testament, and I expressly confer upon her power as such to administer my estate, excusing her from giving any bond or making any returns to the Ordinary or any other Court, and I expressly confer upon her the full authority and power to sell any part of my estate at public or private sale without any order of Court, with or without notice, as she may deem best.
