State of Georgia } In the name of God
Whose County } Amen?

I James S. Moon knowing the mortality of man, and that I must ere long leave the stage of existence with all my domestics, considering being of sound mind & discretion do make and declare this my last will & testament

1st I will that my body be interred in a Christian like manner and as to the goods of this world of which it has pleased God to bless me with I dispose of as follows
1st I will that all my just debts be paid out of the first money collected and it is further my will that all my estate both real & personal be sold to the best advantage for the use of my heirs W^{ts}: Mary Ann Jane my daughter & Jacob David my son and that an equal distribution be made of all the proceeds of my effects when they my son & daughter above named come of age & should either of them die during their minority I will that the other shall have all my effects and provided both my son and daughter die in their minor state I will that my sister Jane Hendon and my dec^d wife's brothers & sisters share my estate each one receiving an equal part I further will and appoint my father-in-law Jacob Moon my Executor to carry this my last will and testament into effect
