of Sarah Battle dec'd

Georgia
Troup County } In the name of
God Amen -

Sarah Battle being of sound mind
and disposing memory, yet feeble in
consequence of age, hath this day
made and ordained, and do hereby
make and ordain this my last will
and testament, revoking all others
heretofore made.

Item 1st My will and desire is that
all of my just and honest debts be paid -
Item 2nd My will and desire is that
my property hereafter named be sold
to wit my negroes Sam, Wiley, Wesley
Ann, Emily, and her two children,
together with all my other increase,
also my house and lot in the town of
Ganfordsville Taliaferro County such
house hold furniture as I may be pos-
sessed

Item 3rd My will and desire is that
after the payments of all my debts
that the ballance of my Estate to
be divided in nine equal shares as
hereafter named - to my son Joseph
John Battle of Marion County one
ninth, John William Battle of Macon
County State of Alabama one ninth -
John Brown Battle of Hancock County
State of Georgia one ninth, to my
son-in-law Christopher A. Carter of
Anton County provided my daughter
Sarah Carter survives, the undersigned
if not then to the children of my

beloved daughter Sarah Carter one sixth
to the children of my affectionate and
beloved daughter Cyrenia Strong lately
the wife of William Strong of Clark
County State of Georgia one sixth -
to my son Lazarus M. Battle of Troup
County one sixth - to my son Oliver
Henry Long of Troup County one sixth -
to my grand children William H. C.
Punkley and Jesse D. Punkley orphan
children of Albert E. Punkley of Punkley
one sixth - to Doctor Samuel Clayton
of Pater County State of Georgia one
ninth -

appoint my son Lazarus M. Battle &
Oliver P. Sears each of Troup County
to take first aforesaid my Executors -

hundred and forty five
