hogs, stock of corn, fodder, oats, wheat, Rye, Potatoes
all the farming utensils, all my household kitchen
furniture, all notes and accounts & evidence of debts
of what character that may be owing and due to me
at my death and also all other portion of property
of which I may be possessed not heretofore enu-
merated or mentioned.

Item 5th I hereby nominate and appoint my
friend Joel Pace of Troup County to be my
Executor.
